Enclosed in this packet you will find the necessary information for registration for the 2009 – 2010 school year. **Please read the entire packet before filling out the registration sheet.** Please return your form as soon as possible (payments do not need to be made until August). *However, you may save \$10 by registering before June 8th.* If you have any questions about the form please do not hesitate to call.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND CHANGES

- Families are required to be registered, active participants in St. Michael parish life especially weekly Mass attendance. **Non-attendance at Mass will result in removal from the program.**
- All families **MUST** fill out the tuition / registration forms even if you have been in the program before
- A **late registration fee** of \$20 will be assigned to all forms received after September 14th
- **Class size will be limited** to 12 students and will be filled on a first come first serve basis.
- All classes shall have a two-deep teaching policy; therefore parents are encouraged to volunteer as either a teacher or an aide. ***If we do not have two teachers per classroom we will not be able to offer classes***
- First Communion is a two-year process. Please keep in mind that first grade is a prerequisite for second grade and First Holy Communion
- Confirmation is a two-year process. Seventh & Eighth grade students are required to attend class regularly and perform service hours.

Preschool registration will take place separately

AVAILABLE PROGRAMS

LEWIS CENTER – This is our satellite PSR program for parishioners who live in Lewis Center. It is held on Tuesday evenings from 5:30 – 6:45 at the Lewis Center United Methodist Church. Grades 1-6

SUNDAY MORNING PROGRAM – This program combines the traditional school of religion with an outstanding adult education program. Families are encouraged to attend the 8:30 AM Mass and then proceed to the school for religious education for both children and adults. 9:45 – 11:15 AM Grades 1-8. Pre-school programs take place during this program. Registration for the pre-school program is on a separate form.

SUNDAY AFTERNOON PROGRAM – This program combines the traditional school of religion with an outstanding adult education program. Families are encouraged to attend the 10:30 AM Mass and then proceed to the school for religious education for both children and adults. 11:45 AM – 1:15 PM Grades 1-8
